

Dr. Mihai SANDULEAC received the MSc. degree in electrical engineering and Ph.D. in expert systems for power networks, from the Polytechnic Institute of Bucharest in 1985 and 1998 respectively. Mihai worked at the Energy Research and Modernizing Institute ICEMENERG Bucharest in various positions, also as head of Research in Power Systems Laboratory. Mihai had various activities in the electrical energy sector, including with companies such as Landis&Gyr for metering systems and Siemens for Power Transmission and Distribution. Mihai is currently Associate Professor in University POLITEHNICA of Bucharest, Department of

Electrical Power Systems. He participated in the FP6 project FENIX, acted as technological manager in H2020 Nobel Grid and is involved in other H2020 projects such as Storage4Grid and SUCCESS. He published various papers and co-authored books in the energy field. Sanduleac is member of IEEE and CIGRE organizations and received the 2011 IEEE-PES Romania Chapter Outstanding Engineer Award.
