Nan Zhou is a Staff Scientist and Department Head of the International Energy Analysis Department, and Group Leader of the China Energy Group. She is also the director of the U.S.- China Clean Energy Center-Building Energy Efficiency (CERC-BEE), a joint presidential initiative started in 2009 by the U.S. and China. Nan was also selected Co-Chair of the 2016 Buildings Summer Study of American Council for an Energy-Efficient Economy (ACEEE), a Committee Member of China Green Building Council in 2015, and a Member of the Balaton Group in 2014. She has been one of the two U.S. government designated Advisory Board Members of the Asia Pacific Energy Research Centre under APEC since 2015, as well as an Advisory Board Member for the APEC Sustainable Energy Center since 2017. She has been appointed to the Applied Energy Editorial Board, and is also a Tianjin University president's appointed Honorary Professor, as well as an Honorary Professor of both Chongqing and Xi'an Jiaotong Universities.
